

EXECUTIVE BOARD OFFICERS ELECTION 2020

Executive Board officers of your union serve two-year terms. The terms of the four current officers expire on June 30, 2020. Accordingly, your union is soliciting nominations and conducting an election for officers to serve a two-year term that begins on July 1, 2020 and ends on June 30, 2022.

Nominations for all four offices are open from April 22, 2020 to May 6, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. You may nominate yourself using the form on the Elections 2020 page. You must be a dues-paying member of our union to vote for and serve as a member of the Executive Board. Voting for all four offices will occur electronically from May 7, 2020 to May 15, 2020 at 5 p.m. The electronic voting will be conducted by Intelliscan, Inc., a CTA-approved independent company experienced in such elections. Results will be posted on our website only, once the votes have been tabulated.

Your union and its officers face challenging times in the current pandemic and in the coming two years. Preparations for negotiations for the next collective bargaining agreement (CBA) must begin in the fall 2020 semester. All of your officers will be involved in that time-consuming task. Negotiations with the District will begin in January 2021 and they, too, are likely to be protracted. In addition, the campaign for equal pay for equal work will be revving up as we return to some form of normalcy on campus. These activities require strong leadership, over and above the designated job descriptions of the officers which can be found beginning on page three (3) of our Bylaws [here](#).
